


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN





1 recommendations on fiscal policy, provide technical assistance to the Office
2 of Finance and Budget, and share information relative to government
3 finances. The senior staff member of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan's* Office of
4 Finance and Budget *shall* serve as Chairperson of the Special Accounting
5 Service.

6 **§13108. Special Economic Service.** There *shall* be a Special
7 Economic Service work group comprised of the Chairman of *I Liheslaturan*
8 *Guåhan's* Committee on Ways and Means, *or* equivalent Standing
9 Committee; the Director of the Office of Finance and Budget; the Public
10 Auditor; the Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research;
11 the Director of Revenue and Taxation; the Director of Administration; the
12 Administrator of the Guam Economic Development and Commerce
13 Authority; the Chief Economist of the Department of Labor; the Chief
14 Economist of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans; and the Administrator of
15 Research and Evaluation (Research Manager) of the Guam Visitors Bureau.
16 Said Service *shall* meet from time to time to discuss and develop
17 recommendations on economic policy, provide technical assistance to the
18 Office of Finance and Budget, and share information relative to the state of
19 the economy. The Chairperson of the Committee on Ways and Means, *or*
20 equivalent Standing Committee, *shall* serve as Chairperson of the Special
21 Economic Service.”

22 **Section 42. Guam Public School System to Develop and Implement**
23 **Performance Based Budgeting.** A new §3132 is *added* to Chapter 3, Title 17
24 GCA to read:

25 “§3132. **Central Office Budgeting.** Guam Public School System
26 (GPSS) *shall* develop and implement Performance Based Budgeting for all
27 Central Office Operations *no later than* September 30, 2009. Appropriate

1 GPSS employees *shall* attend all workshops and training opportunities
2 offered by the Department of Administration regarding Performance Based
3 Budgeting.”

4 **Section 43.** A new Section 4118 is *added* to Chapter 4 of Title 5 GCA to
5 read:

6 **“§4118. Development and Implementation of Performance Based**
7 **Budgeting.** The heads of the Department of Administration, the Bureau of
8 Budget and Management Research, the Department of Revenue and
9 Taxation, the Department of Public Works, the Department of Parks and
10 Recreation, the Department of Land Management, the Department of
11 Agriculture, and the Bureau of Statistics and Plans *shall* develop and
12 implement Performance Based Budgeting *no later than* September 30, 2009.
13 Appropriate employees of said agencies *shall* attend all workshops and
14 training opportunities regarding Performance Based Budgeting offered by
15 the Department of Administration.”

16 **Section 44. Appropriation for Department of Revenue and Taxation**
17 **Computer Systems Upgrade and Integration.** Section 8 of Chapter I of P.L. 29-
18 03 is hereby *amended* to read:

19 **“Section 8. Appropriation for Department of Revenue and**
20 **Taxation Computer Systems Upgrade and Integration.** The sum of One
21 Million Two Hundred Sixty-one Thousand Dollars (**\$1,261,000**) is
22 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Revenue and
23 Taxation for computer system upgrades and hardware and software
24 integration at the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Said General Fund
25 appropriation *shall* come from the approximately Twenty-one Million
26 Dollars (\$21,000,000) received by the government of Guam from the federal
27 government for tax reimbursements. The funds appropriated herein *shall* be
